LFRC uses its many in house resources, as well as collaborating with its many partner agencies in efforts to provide fast, efficient services to our families in need.

Upon being referred to DR, a young mother of a 2 year old, her new DR advocate, and representatives of other agencies were invited to a Family Team Meeting at CWS. From there, a case plan was created based on the mother's initial needs. The plan could then be carried out in a timely efficient manner in order to not overwhelm the mother or the new DR advocate. An employee Service social worker from D.S.S. was able to provide the mother with a better understanding of her cash aid, as well as job training and childcare info. A social worker from CWS was able to make a referral to Behavioral Health for mother to get into much needed counseling services. The DR advocate agreed to provide mother with assistance with transportation and basic needs, as well as ongoing home visiting and support in order for the mother to reach her goals.
