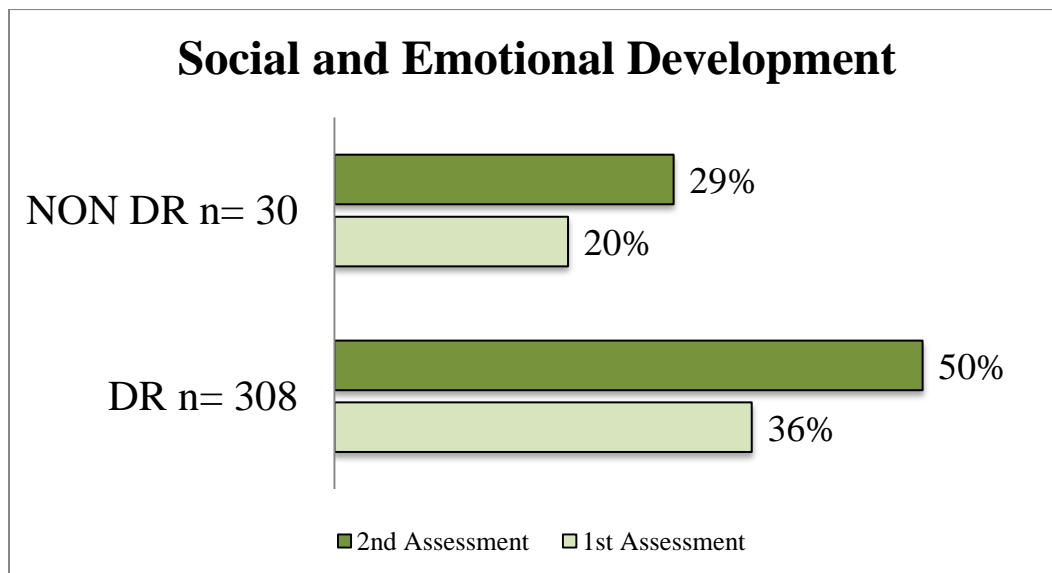

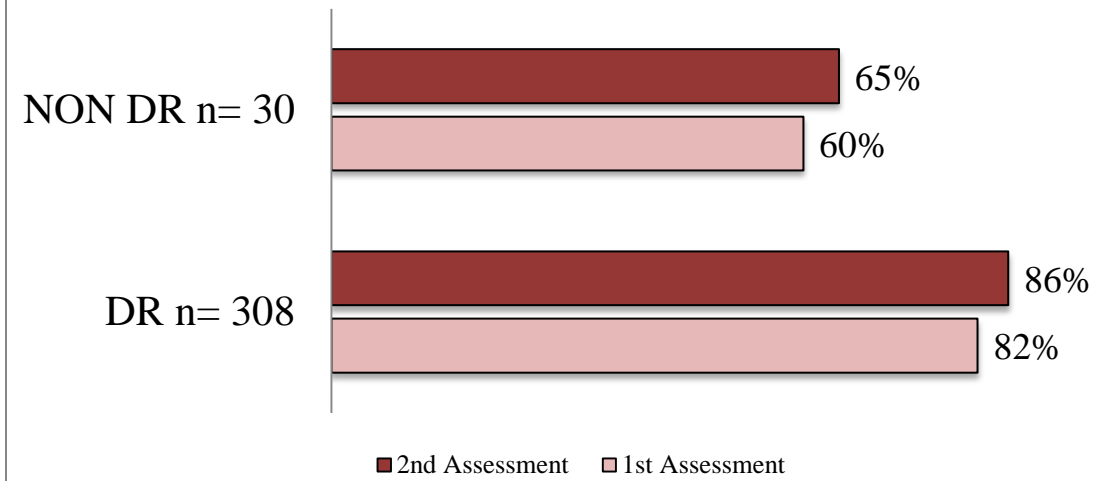

Change by protective factor for DR vs. Non DR.

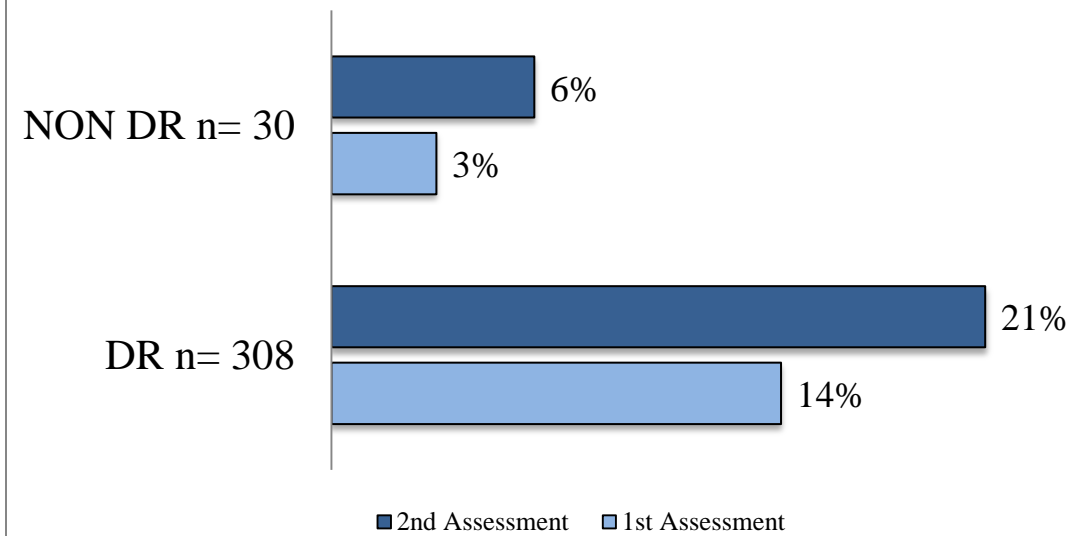
Percentage of clients at the self sufficient or safe in all indicators considered for the protective factor



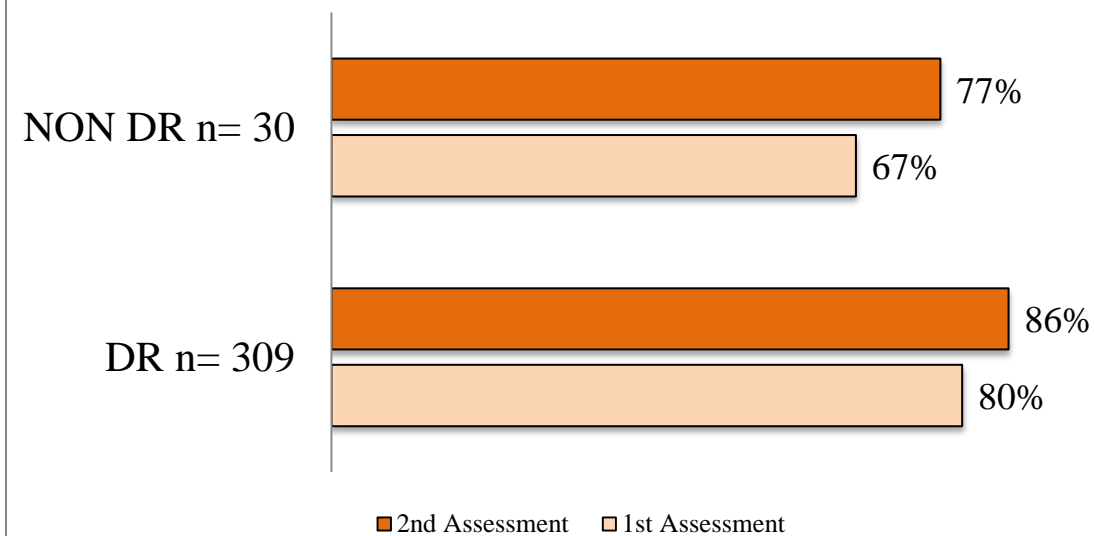
