Community Status Levels

Safe/Self-Sufficient (4)

The community is secure as a result of its own efforts and has clear goals for its future.

Stable (3)

Planning for future is ongoing using community resources.

At-risk (2)


Community may be secure from immediate threats to health and safety, but has not yet developed long-term plan.

In-crisis (1)

Reflects a community in survival mode. Systems are near collapse. Strong outside intervention is needed.


