Geographical Focus

Being in a frontier area impacts our programs tremendously. We are in a no-man's land for funding opportunities. We don't have the population to apply for large grants. We aren't a Tribal entity so we don't qualify for those programs. We are in Northern California but funding agencies that say they fund Northern California do not fund this far north. We can find programmatic funding for a year or two but they generally do not fit the programs already being offered and they never fund operating or general staff costs so it is extremely difficult.
