We have worked with a mother of 3 for about 3 years, we met her when she fled her domestic violence situation and moved into the shelter and started taking parenting and family-based substance abuse relapse prevention classes at our Center. She lost her kids for a time, and she worked really hard to get them returned to her home. She became a poster child for showing others that you can quit drugs and a bad relationship, and with hard work, be successful, even speaking on panels for conferences, and joining the Community Services Council Substance Abuse Subcommittee. Her son, who is now 10, was our youngest volunteer here at our center, filling out an application at age 8, so that he could buy a pair of roller skates from our Thrift store (earning \$ 1/hour of store credit) He just recently made a deal with our Karate instructor, giving him his \$ 10/month allowance and doing cleaning in the Dojo so that he can take Karate classes here! He is a delightful young man, who spends a lot of time here and is learning what kids are good to hang out with and those that are not!
