Success Story



An unemployed single mother with five boys, who was receiving public assistance, was evicted from her home of three years. The Community Center learned of her situation and approached her to provide help. The Center's Community Liaison contacted Humboldt Housing Now and a nearby

property manager. After eviction, the family stayed with a friend in a one-bedroom cabin as arrangements were made by Humboldt Housing Now with a new landlord at a trailer park. Humboldt Housing Now helped pay her rent and deposit. This allowed her boys to stay in the same school district. We helped her with transportation in the form of gas cards provided through our Safety Net funding.

With Safety Net funding, we paid the propane service deposit so that the family could cook and have heat, and also supplied them with sheets and blankets. The Safety Net Fund was provided by the partnership of St. Joseph Health System, Smullin Foundation, First 5 Humboldt, Humboldt Area Foundation, United Way of Humboldt, Headwaters Fund, and McLean Foundation.

This family also routinely received food from the Center's food bank. The family was so excited to be in a home with a kitchen that they made cookies to celebrate on their first night.
