Mandated Program: The in-Home Parent Aide program provides family maintenance as well as Family Re-unification services by paraprofessionals in the home to parents who need assistance in developing parenting and child rearing skills required to maintain their child(ren) at home, or to return the child(ren) to the home setting.

Pathways Program: Pathways empowers families by providing the resources and services they need to stay together, grow stronger, and maintain a healthy and safe home environment. Pathways is designed to provide assistance before problems get bigger.

SafeCare Program: SafeCare is an evidenced-based parent training curriculum, The SafeCare providers teach families specific skills in how to manage child behavior, keep their home free of safety hazards, and take care of a childs basic needs health care needs, three specific modules will be used Safety Module, Health Module, and Parent Child Interaction/Parent Infant Interaction Module

COEDS Program? COEDS is a service provided at no cost to families via the Individualized Education Program (IEP) process. It helps students who are facing challenges in accessing their Special Education program by providing additional supports outside of school. COEDS services are designed to address the student's IEP goals in social, emotional or behavioral areas,.
