Mission Statement

To strengthen relationships by providing safe, supportive help that keep family members emotionally connected to one another.

Programs and Services

Alice's House – Cooperative living housing for current or former foster youth/youth from child welfare system; that focuses on building self-sufficiency in areas of education, employment, housing, money management, self-care and cooperative living.

Counseling Services – Family interventions focusing on children and adolescents who have experienced trauma in their caregiving systems.

Early Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) – Provide trauma informed clinical services in-home and/or in-office and case management services.

In-Home Placement Training -In-home education and training for newly licensed foster caregivers.

Kinship Support Services Program (KSSP)- Provide Relative Approval Training, case management, education and support services for kinship families (relative caregivers, primarily grandparents raising grandchildren). An HSA program.

Peer Education and Training: Connects new foster parents with experienced foster parents providing support and education.

Family Attachment Model (FAM)– Provide in-home and/or in-office family therapy focused on therapeutic parenting techniques to increase child's attachment with caregiver. An HSA program.

Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI)- Countywide and community coalitions and one on one Peer Partners to help kinship families navigate the system and access community resources. An HSA program.

Relational Assessment Program (RAP) – A 19-week in-home therapeutic program for birth families in the child welfare system.

Support, Education and Training (SET) – Weekly in-home services specializing in topics relevant to foster and kinship caregivers of children who have experienced trauma, loss, grief, prenatal drug and/or alcohol exposure and multiple placement changes.

Success Story

We had new adoptive parents whose twins were expressing rage and anger at home while behaving very nicely and calmly in school and other areas outside the home. The parents tried all kinds of resources to no avail. They were referred to Kids & Families Together and although they lived over 100 miles away round trip, the therapy services they received from K&FT transformed their family.

The girls began to smile and laugh at home and the family became closer. The family believes this would not have happened if they had not found us.
