Success Story

Camille is the mother of five children between the ages of four and fourteen years old. Camille is a single mother and an immigrant refugee who struggles to speak and understand English. The Sunset FRC connected with Camille after receiving a referral from truancy office of the school district regarding her oldest two children missing too much school. Camille shared that she is doing the best she can with her children but they do not listen to her and they do not follow any rules. Camille expressed that she was very overwhelmed and felt hopeless. The Sunset FRC staff met with the mother and school staff to get a plan in place with her older children, whereby they agreed to attend school. Since then, they have been attending school regularly and there have been no other truancy issues reported. Camille also now works with a case manager who speaks her native language on a weekly basis. Camille reports that things in her home are much better now, and she is learning a lot about how to interact with her children and establish rules in the home. Additionally, Camille is taking ESL classes to learn English and is making great progress.
